Purchasing an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

An AED is a device used in conjunction with CPR on a person experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. It analyzes the heart's electrical rhythm and, if necessary, prompts you to deliver a shock that disrupts a heart's electrical activity long enough to allow the heart to spontaneously develop an effective rhythm on its own.

Standard First Aid with CPR—Adult or Standard First Aid with CPR/AED—Adult

Classroom Length: 6-1/2 hours; 7-1/2 hours with AED.

Online Length: 3 hours; Skills Assessment: 2 hours.

Course Fee: \$50.00; \$60.00 with AED.

To care for persons older than 12, this course provides first aid and adult CPR training and explains the role of AEDs in emergency cardiac care. Online training is a great alternative for students who learn best on their own or who like to work at their own pace. The first part of the training is completed at your convenience online. For the second part, participants are required to attend one of the scheduled skill assessments below. Will I receive a confirmation – and can I get a receipt? You can receive a class confirmation and receipt by sending a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your Registration Form. If you register online, you will receive an e-mail confirmation. Remember to verify the date and time of your training session as it appears on your confirmation.

Can I take a class if I have a medical condition or a special educational need?
